

Updated Kensington White Plains Visitation Plan

Effective January 2023

Guidelines for visitors to The Kensington are shown below and are in alignment with guidance provided by the CDC and New York Dept of Health:

Age Limit: There is no age limit. Children under 10 must be accompanied by an adult. All visitors 2 years old and older, and medically able to tolerate a face covering/ mask, must wear a mask while in the community.

Health Screening: To protect our residents and team, the Concierge welcomes all visitors, and ensures each guest signs in/out and is screened for COVID symptoms and fever. Should a visitor exhibit these symptom or fever, the visitor will be asked to refrain from visiting. If the visitor is aware that they have recently been exposed to COVID, extra care should be taken to with masking, hand sanitation and distancing from residents.

Social Distancing: All visitors are encouraged to maintain at least 6 feet of separation from residents, team members, and other visitors while in common areas.

Vaccinations: Visitors are not required to provide proof of vaccination.

Negative COVID test: Visitors are not required to provide proof of a negative COVID test. .

Sanitation: Alcohol-based hand sanitizer is available throughout the community. Visitors are strongly encouraged to use hand sanitizer prior to and after each visit. Our team disinfects all common areas regularly.

Visitor Events: If families wish to have a group function (i.e. birthday celebration, family in from out of town, etc.) they need to notify our staff so the event can be scheduled and properly planned for.

Scheduling Visits: Pre-scheduling of visits is not required.

Visitation hours: Hours of visitation are not restricted.

COVID 19 Positive: Visitors will be notified if the resident(s) they wish to visit are positive for COVID and are on isolation or in quarantine. In these cases, visitors must adhere to infection control precautions for hand washing/ sanitizing and the use of Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) including gloves, mask, eye protection and gown during the visit. Staff will assist with instruction as to the proper use and disposal of PPE.
